Parent Responsibilities

1. Parents will treat players, coaches, officials, and opponents with respect. This includes personal interactions as well as social media postings.
2. Parents will be asked to keep a positive attitude when addressing members of the team, opponents and officials.
3. Coaching is to be done by the coaches on staff. Parents agree to refrain from coaching and directing their child or other players during the game. *If this becomes a problem, a meeting with the Athletic Director will occur.*
4. Parents will discuss player and team concerns directly with a coach before talking to the athletic director. These meetings will not happen directly before or after a game but will be scheduled for a later date. If the concern is unresolved after the meeting, the parent can contact the athletic director at that time.
5. Parents understand that this is a non-equal playing time environment and playing time will not be discussed.
6. Parents understand that it is their daughter or son's duty to bring any concerns they have to coaches first before parents talk with coaches about it.
7. Parents will make sure their daughter/son attends all practices, meetings and games.
8. Parents will make sure that if a student is going to be late to school, leave in the middle, or not attend for any reason they need to contact the school before 8:30 a.m. that day, or the student athlete will not be able to participate in practice or games that day.
9. Parents will pick up their daughters and sons on time after practice and games.

Eligibility

- Student will be ineligible:
 - After 5th demerit - Students who are ineligible will have a maximum suspension of one game.
 - Receiving a failing grade "F" - Ineligibility lasts one week (Monday to Monday); that also includes Monday night games as well. Students are still allowed to practice with team and attend games. However, students are NOT allowed to play or suit up.
- If your child receives two consecutive "F's" in the same quarter, they will be required to attend Homework Club until the end of the quarter.
- If you have concerns that your child is going to be ineligible, **please check PowerSchool** and see what needs to be turned in BEFORE grade checks on Monday.
- Students will have until 2:00 p.m. every Monday, during the grade check period, to raise their grade to a passing one. If it isn't passing by then, they are ineligible for that week.
- ISS or OSS Policy
 - If a student receives an ISS or OSS, they are not allowed to either practice or participate in any CSAL athletic event for one week.
